1003 participants ! => 991 registered persons, including 57 virtual + 12 free participants to symposia

About 40% of students

Transport : 17 by bike; ONLY 43 by plane; 647 by train/public transports; 124 by car sharing + 61 by car

Number of talks: about 380 in regular sessions, about 120 in symposia, and more than 200 posters




